PREAMBLE

We, the members of Jaipur Cricket Circle (JCC), recognize the power of cricket to foster friendship, discipline, sportsmanship, leadership and community spirit. This Community Charter serves as the guiding framework for the governance, organization and future development of the community.

OUR VISION

To build Jaipur's most welcoming and enjoyable amateur cricket community where people come together to play competitive cricket, make friendships, stay active and create lasting memories.

OUR MISSION

- Organize fair and enjoyable cricket matches and tournaments.
- Provide opportunities for players of all skill levels.
- Promote sportsmanship, discipline and mutual respect.
- Value participation as much as performance.
- Continuously improve the quality and professionalism of our events.

OUR CORE VALUES

At Jaipur Cricket Circle, we believe in playing with respect, competing with integrity and growing together as a community. We value sportsmanship, fairness, inclusivity and accountability.

GOVERNANCE STRUCTURE

To ensure effective governance, operational efficiency, and long-term sustainability, Jaipur Cricket Circle (JCC) shall function through a two-tier leadership structure consisting of the **Core Committee** and the **Executive Committee**.

This structure is designed to balance strategic decision-making with efficient execution while ensuring that community interests remain at the center of all activities.

1. Core Committee

The Core Committee shall be the highest governing body of Jaipur Cricket Circle and shall be entrusted with the overall direction, governance, and stewardship of the community.

Composition

The Core Committee shall comprise:

- Opal
- Nitin
- Nitesh
- Abhijeet
- Sagar

Powers and Responsibilities

The Core Committee shall have the authority to:

- Define the long-term vision, mission, and strategic direction of JCC.
- Formulate, interpret, and amend the Community Charter.
- Establish community policies, frameworks, and governance standards.
- Approve tournament structures, formats, and major community initiatives.
- Appoint, rotate, continue, or remove Team Captains.

- Appoint or remove members of the Executive Committee where applicable.
- Resolve disputes and conflicts escalated beyond the operational level.
- Exercise oversight over community finances and major expenditures.
- Approve the admission, suspension, or removal of members where necessary.
- Safeguard the values, culture, and long-term interests of the community.

The decisions of the Core Committee shall be considered final and binding in matters relating to governance, policy interpretation, leadership appointments, and strategic direction.

2. Executive Committee

The Executive Committee shall serve as the operational leadership body of Jaipur Cricket Circle and shall be responsible for implementing the vision, policies, and decisions of the Core Committee.

Composition

The Executive Committee shall consist of:

Permanent Members

- All Core Committee Members
- Sh. Anil Rawat
- Sh. Rudraksha Jhalani

Ex-Officio Members

- All serving Team Captains shall automatically become members of the Executive Committee for the duration of their captaincy.

Powers and Responsibilities

The Executive Committee shall:

- Coordinate and execute weekly cricket activities.
- Assist in organizing tournaments, leagues, and special events.
- Support venue management and match-day operations.
- Facilitate communication between players, captains, and the Core Committee.
- Recommend improvements relating to competition formats, participation, and community engagement.
- Assist in maintaining discipline and resolving routine operational issues.
- Promote member participation and community expansion.
- Provide feedback and recommendations to the Core Committee on matters affecting the community.

The Executive Committee may deliberate upon operational matters and make recommendations; however, it shall not possess authority to override decisions of the Core Committee.

3. Relationship Between the Core Committee and Executive Committee

The Core Committee and Executive Committee shall work collaboratively to ensure the effective functioning of Jaipur Cricket Circle.

For the avoidance of doubt:

- The Core Committee shall primarily focus on governance, policy, and strategic matters.
- The Executive Committee shall primarily focus on execution, operations, and implementation.
- The Executive Committee may make recommendations, but final authority shall remain with the Core Committee.
- Captains shall represent the interests and perspectives of players through their participation in the Executive Committee.
- Matters having significant financial, governance, disciplinary, or structural implications shall be referred to the Core Committee for consideration and approval.

4. Guiding Principle

The purpose of this governance structure is not to create hierarchy for its own sake, but to ensure that Jaipur Cricket Circle remains transparent, organized, inclusive, and capable of sustainable growth while preserving the spirit of friendship, sportsmanship, and community that forms its foundation.

5. Decision-Making Framework

A. Core Committee

The Core Committee shall strive to make decisions through discussion, consultation, and consensus wherever possible.

Where consensus cannot be reached, decisions may be determined through a vote of the Core Committee members.

Voting Procedure

- Each Core Committee member shall have one vote.
- A simple majority of members present shall be sufficient for approval of a proposal.
- In the event of a tie, the matter shall be reconsidered through further discussion.
- If the deadlock persists, the proposal may either be deferred for reconsideration at a later meeting or resolved through a unanimous decision of the remaining Core Committee members.

Quorum Requirement

- A minimum of three (3) Core Committee members must be present for any decision to be considered valid.
- Decisions taken without the required quorum shall be treated as recommendations until ratified by the required quorum.

Reserved Powers

The following matters shall remain exclusively within the authority of the Core Committee:

- Amendments to the Community Charter.
- Appointment or removal of Captains.

- Appointment or removal of Executive Committee members.
- Admission, suspension, or removal of members.
- Major financial decisions and community restructuring.
- Final resolution of disputes and disciplinary matters.

B. Executive Committee

The Executive Committee shall primarily function as an operational and advisory body and shall seek to make decisions through consultation and consensus.

Voting Procedure

- Each Executive Committee member shall have one vote.
- Operational matters may be approved through a simple majority of members present.
- Decisions of the Executive Committee shall not override decisions of the Core Committee.

Quorum Requirement

- A minimum of two third percent (75%) of Executive Committee members shall constitute a quorum.
- Where quorum is not met, discussions may continue, but decisions shall remain provisional until confirmed by the required quorum.

Deadlock Resolution

- In the event of an unresolved deadlock within the Executive Committee, the matter shall be referred to the Core Committee.
- The Core Committee shall review the issue and communicate a final decision.

Proposal, Amendment, and Policy Review Process

Jaipur Cricket Circle (JCC) encourages active participation from all members in the growth, development, and continuous improvement of the community. Every member shall have the opportunity to contribute ideas, suggestions, recommendations, and constructive feedback relating to the functioning of the community.

1. Submission of Proposals

Any member of JCC may submit a proposal, suggestion, concern, or recommendation relating to:

- Community governance and administration.
- Tournament formats and competition structures.
- Team management and player participation.
- Financial matters.
- Community activities and events.
- Amendments to the Community Charter.
- Any other matter affecting the interests of the community.

Such proposals may be communicated to any member of the Executive Committee for consideration.

2. Executive Committee Review

Upon receipt of a proposal, the Executive Committee shall review and discuss the matter at an appropriate meeting or forum.

Following deliberation, the Executive Committee may:

- Approve the proposal.

- Reject the proposal.
- Recommend modifications.
- Conduct a community poll where wider member participation is desirable.
- Refer the proposal to the Core Committee where the matter involves governance, finance, disciplinary action, structural changes, or Community Charter amendments.

3. Community Polls and Member Consultation

For routine operational matters affecting the general membership, the Executive Committee may conduct polls, surveys, or consultations amongst community members to ascertain the collective opinion of the community.

Such matters may include:

- Match timings.
- Venue selection.
- Match dates and scheduling.
- Tournament formats.
- Community activities and events.
- Playing conditions and operational arrangements.
- Other routine matters affecting member participation.

The Executive Committee may consider the outcome of such polls while making recommendations or decisions.

Where appropriate, the Executive Committee may adopt the outcome of a community poll as the final decision on routine operational matters.

4. Matters Requiring Core Committee Approval

The following matters shall require approval of the Core Committee irrespective of any recommendation made by the Executive Committee:

- Amendments to the Community Charter.
- Governance and policy matters.
- Appointment or removal of Captains.
- Appointment or removal of Executive Committee members.
- Membership suspension or removal.
- Significant financial commitments or expenditures.
- Structural changes to the community.
- Disciplinary matters and dispute resolution.
- Any matter referred by the Executive Committee.

6. Final Authority

The Core Committee shall have final authority regarding the approval, modification, interpretation, implementation, or rejection of proposals, policies, amendments, and matters affecting Jaipur Cricket Circle.

The decision of the Core Committee shall be final and binding upon all members.

Membership Eligibility & Admission Process

- Membership is open to individuals who share the values and objectives of JCC.
- Admission of new members shall be subject to approval by the Executive Committee.
- Members are expected to abide by the Community Charter.
- Membership may be suspended or revoked in cases of serious misconduct or actions contrary to the interests of the community.

CAPTAIN SELECTION FRAMEWORK

Captains shall be selected based on leadership, communication, contribution to the community, commitment, reliability and sportsmanship. Captaincy is a responsibility and not a privilege. **Final authority rests with the Core Committee.**

ETHICS & CONDUCT

Members shall play honestly, respect match outcomes, accept umpiring decisions, support fair play and treat all participants respectfully.

CONFLICT MANAGEMENT

Disagreements and differences of opinion are a natural part of any competitive sporting environment. Members are encouraged to address concerns constructively and respectfully.

Step 1

Players should discuss issues respectfully and privately with the concerned individual whenever possible, with the objective of reaching an amicable resolution.

Step 2

If the matter remains unresolved, members may raise their concerns with their respective Team Captain or senior members of the community, including Nitin, Anil Rawat, or Sagar.

Step 3

Where further intervention is required, the matter shall be reviewed by the Core Committee comprising Opal, Nitin, Nitesh, Abhijeet, and Sagar. The Committee will consider the matter objectively, hear relevant viewpoints if necessary, and communicate its decision in the best interests of the community.

Personal attacks, public arguments, abusive language, harassment, or attempts to create divisions within the community will not be tolerated. All members are expected to uphold the spirit of mutual respect and sportsmanship both on and off the field.

TOURNAMENT STRUCTURE

To ensure greater participation, balanced competition, and sustained community growth, Jaipur Cricket Circle shall adopt the following tournament structure:

1. Three-Team Format

Going forward, regular Sunday cricket shall primarily be conducted in a three-team format. Players may be rotated between teams from time to time to maintain competitive balance and provide an enjoyable experience for all participants.

2. Community Above Team Loyalty

While healthy team rivalries are encouraged, members are discouraged from developing excessive loyalty to any particular team. The objective of JCC is to promote good cricket, sportsmanship, and community spirit above individual team affiliations.

3. Equal Opportunity for Participation

The three-team structure has been adopted to maximize participation and provide fair opportunities for all members to play, contribute, and develop their skills.

4. Future Expansion

As the community continues to grow, the structure may be expanded to include four, five, six, or more teams, depending on the number of active members and operational requirements.

5. Monthly Championship Tournament

On every fourth Sunday, JCC shall organize a special paid tournament. A nominal participation fee may be collected from members to support tournament arrangements. Subject to available funds and resources, provisions may include refreshments, awards, trophies, medals,

certificates, or prize money for outstanding performances and winning teams.

6. Rankings and Championships

To encourage both competitive excellence and long-term consistency, JCC shall maintain two separate ranking systems:

a) Weekend Tournament Ranking

- Based on performances in the Sunday tournaments and finals.
- Teams will earn recognition based on their ability to perform under tournament conditions and win finals.

b) Season Ranking

- Based exclusively on league-stage matches.
- Finals shall not be included in season ranking calculations.
- After a predetermined number of league matches (for example, 15–20 matches or as decided by the organizers), a Season Champion Team shall be declared based on overall performance.
- This dual-ranking structure ensures that both consistency and championship-winning ability are recognized.

7. Statistics and Performance Records

Player and team statistics shall be maintained and published periodically. These may include batting, bowling, fielding, team performances, rankings, records, milestones, and other relevant achievements. The objective is to recognize contributions, promote healthy competition, and preserve the history of the community.

FINANCIAL PRINCIPLES

The financial affairs of Jaipur Cricket Circle (JCC) shall be conducted with transparency, accountability, prudence, and in the best interests of the community. All funds collected or utilized by the community shall be managed responsibly and solely for purposes that support the objectives, activities, and development of JCC.

1. Financial Contributions and Member Obligations

Members may be required to contribute financially towards community activities, including but not limited to:

- Ground booking charges.
- Tournament participation fees.
- Special event contributions.
- Equipment, refreshments, awards, trophies, medals, certificates, or other community-related expenses.
- Any other approved expenditure incurred for the benefit of the community.
- Members shall be informed of applicable financial obligations prior to participation wherever reasonably possible.

2. Cost Structure and Financial Transparency

JCC shall endeavor to maintain complete transparency regarding the collection and utilization of community funds.

Where applicable, members shall be informed regarding:

- The nature and purpose of the expenditure.
- Estimated and actual costs incurred.
- The basis for determining member contributions.
- The intended utilization of collected funds.
- Any participation fees, tournament fees, or special contributions shall be communicated in advance along with the rationale for such charges.

- New members shall be provided adequate information regarding the financial expectations associated with participation in community activities.

3. Treasurer

The Core Committee shall designate a Treasurer from amongst its members or any other suitable member from the Executive Committee.

The Treasurer shall be responsible for:

- Managing community funds and financial transactions.
- Maintaining records of collections and expenditures.
- Keeping appropriate accounts and supporting documentation.
- Coordinating payment collection where required.
- Preparing financial summaries and reports.
- Assisting the Core Committee in budgeting and financial planning.

The Treasurer shall perform these duties in a transparent and accountable manner and shall remain answerable to the Core Committee.

4. Financial Reporting and Record Maintenance

To maintain trust and transparency within the community:

- Financial records shall be maintained in an organized and verifiable manner.
- Collections, expenditures, and balances shall be documented appropriately.
- Financial updates may be shared periodically with members whenever deemed necessary by the Core Committee.
- A financial summary may be published following major tournaments, special events, or significant expenditure activities.

5. Approval of Expenditures

Routine operational expenses upto INR 20,000 /- relating to ground bookings, tournament organization, refreshments, awards, and other approved community activities may be incurred by the Executive Committee

Any expenditure exceeding the limit of INR 20,000/- shall require prior approval from the simple majority of the Core Committee.

The Core Committee may prescribe expenditure limits, approval thresholds, or financial controls from time to time to ensure prudent management of community resources.

6. Accountability and Use of Funds

All funds collected under the name of Jaipur Cricket Circle shall be utilized exclusively for community purposes.

No member shall derive personal financial benefit from community funds except for legitimate reimbursement of approved expenses incurred on behalf of JCC.

Any misuse, misrepresentation, or unauthorized utilization of community funds shall be subject to review by the Core Committee and may result in disciplinary action.

Health, Safety, and Injury Management Protocols

Jaipur Cricket Circle (JCC) is committed to promoting a safe, healthy, and enjoyable environment for all participants. While cricket is inherently a physical sport and participation involves certain risks, every reasonable effort shall be made to safeguard the well-being of members during community activities.

1. Player Safety and Well-Being

All members are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that prioritizes safety, respect, and responsible participation.

Members are encouraged to:

- Participate only when physically fit to do so.
- Exercise appropriate care for their own safety and the safety of others.
- Use suitable playing equipment and protective gear where necessary.
- Avoid reckless, dangerous, or intentionally harmful conduct.
- Follow instructions issued by organizers, captains, or designated officials in matters relating to safety.

2. Health Disclosure

Members are encouraged to voluntarily inform organizers, captains, or designated community representatives of any significant medical conditions, injuries, allergies, or health concerns that may require special attention during participation.

Such information shall be treated with appropriate confidentiality and shall only be used for the purpose of ensuring participant safety and well-being.

3. Injury and Medical Incident Management

In the event of an injury, medical emergency, or health-related incident occurring during a JCC activity:

- Play may be suspended temporarily if required.
- Immediate assistance shall be provided by available members and organizers.
- Appropriate medical attention shall be sought whenever necessary.
- Emergency services may be contacted in serious situations.
- Organizers may contact the injured member's emergency contact where circumstances warrant such action.
- The safety and well-being of the affected individual shall take precedence over match or tournament considerations.

4. First-Aid and Emergency Preparedness

JCC shall endeavor, wherever reasonably practicable, to maintain basic first-aid arrangements during organized events.

Organizers may:

- Maintain access to a basic first-aid kit.
- Identify nearby medical facilities where feasible.
- Ensure that emergency contact information is available when required.
- Coordinate emergency response efforts in the event of serious incidents.

However, members acknowledge that JCC is a community-based amateur sports organization and may not always have professional medical personnel present during activities.

5. Personal Responsibility

Participation in JCC activities is voluntary and undertaken at the member's own discretion.

Each member remains responsible for:

- Assessing their own fitness and readiness to participate.
- Seeking appropriate medical advice where necessary.
- Maintaining adequate personal health and safety precautions.
- Immediately reporting any injury, discomfort, or medical concern arising during participation.
- Members are encouraged to prioritize their health and refrain from participating when injured, unwell, or medically unfit.

6. Safety Practices

To promote a safe playing environment, members are encouraged to:

- Warm up adequately before matches.
- Stay hydrated during activities.
- Use appropriate footwear and playing equipment.
- Respect playing conditions and venue-specific safety requirements.
- Exercise caution in adverse weather or unsafe ground conditions.
- Report any hazards, unsafe conditions, or safety concerns to organizers promptly.

Limitation of Responsibility

Jaipur Cricket Circle (JCC), its Core Committee, Executive Committee, Captains, organizers, volunteers, and members shall make reasonable efforts to promote a safe and well-organized environment for all community activities.

However, participation in cricket and related activities involves inherent risks, including the possibility of injury, illness, property damage, or other unforeseen incidents.

Accordingly, JCC shall not be held responsible or liable for:

- Injuries, accidents, or medical conditions arising from participation in community activities.
- Loss, theft, or damage to personal belongings or equipment.
- Actions, omissions, or conduct of individual participants.
- Circumstances arising from weather conditions, venue conditions, or other factors beyond the reasonable control of the community.
- Any indirect, incidental, or consequential losses suffered by participants.

By participating in JCC activities, members acknowledge and accept the inherent risks associated with amateur sporting activities and agree to participate voluntarily and at their own discretion.

Nothing in this provision shall prevent JCC from taking reasonable measures to promote participant safety and well-being.

LOOKING AHEAD

JCC aims to become a recognized cricket community known for sportsmanship, professional organization, strong friendships and positive impact on local sports culture.
